I hope I can keep them alive and thriving! I absolutely love the idea of returning the native plants to their « home »



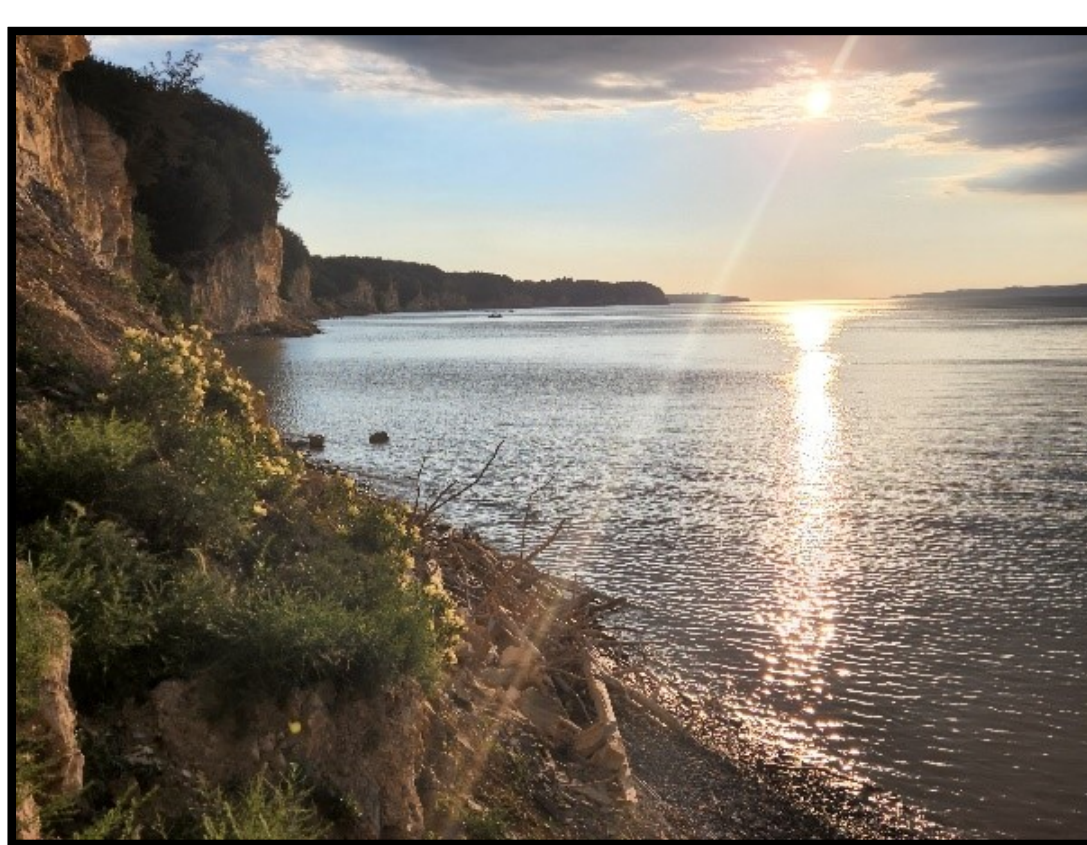

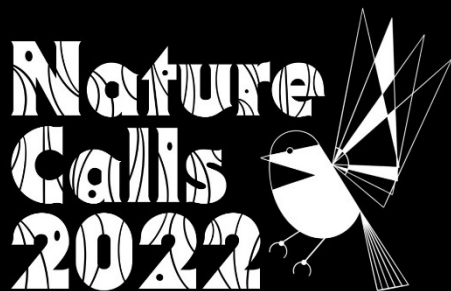
So we returned at Sunset for the show! Oh MY!
