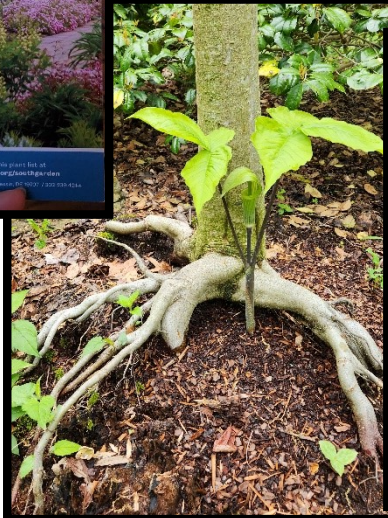
What a Week of "A NEW Nature Garden Pilgrimage!"

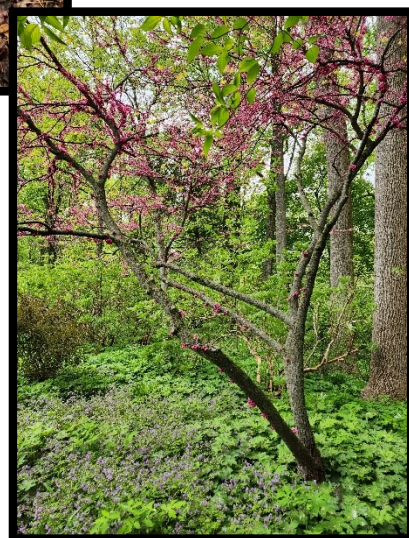
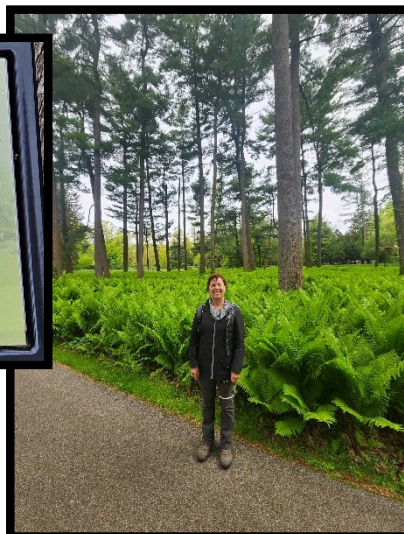


Mass plantings of each species, clean and defined edges, pathways mown or of permeable materials, plant ID!

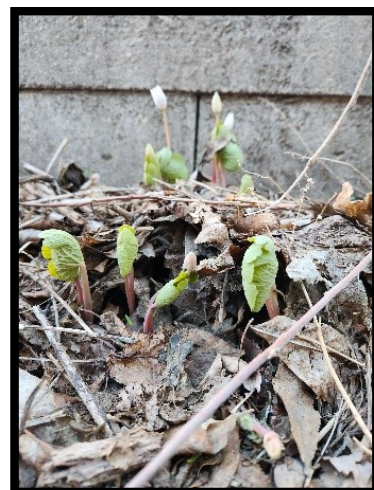
SIOUX CITY GARDEN CLUB
