

Complete Guide To Sneezeweed (Helenium Autumnale)

For a showy late-blooming native flower that bridges the gap from Summer to Fall, look no further than Sneezeweed. This lovely plant makes a gorgeous yellow display that blooms after the main summer flowers have finished, and before to coinciding with Asters. I've successfully grown this plant for several years and will share what I've learned with you.



Below, Goldenrod is COVERED in pollinators right now! We counted over 12 unique pollinators on a single plume!

Sneezeweed that does NOT make you sneeze! We like to call this gorgeous and unique plant Helen's Flower or Helenia! It sounds so much better to us, haha! At *The Wild Mess in Progress*, it is a mix of blooms and ready to harvest seeds! On purpose! If you do NOT want seeds, and want this gorgeous plant to bloom through until frost, deadhead the blossoms regularly! The



seeds are ready when you gently squeeze the brown, dry seed head and it falls off into your container. It does not take long to have a LOT of seed! We will be sharing this seed liberally at the November 12th Potluck, Annual Meeting, and Seed Share from



2-4PM at the Sioux City Public Museum! Please join us! We will have plenty of food-- and seeds-- to SHARE!



White, Yellow, and Purple seem to be the dominant colors this Fall in Iowa!

The white Snow-on-the Mountain is going to seed as well, not quite ready yet!

We will check it daily!


