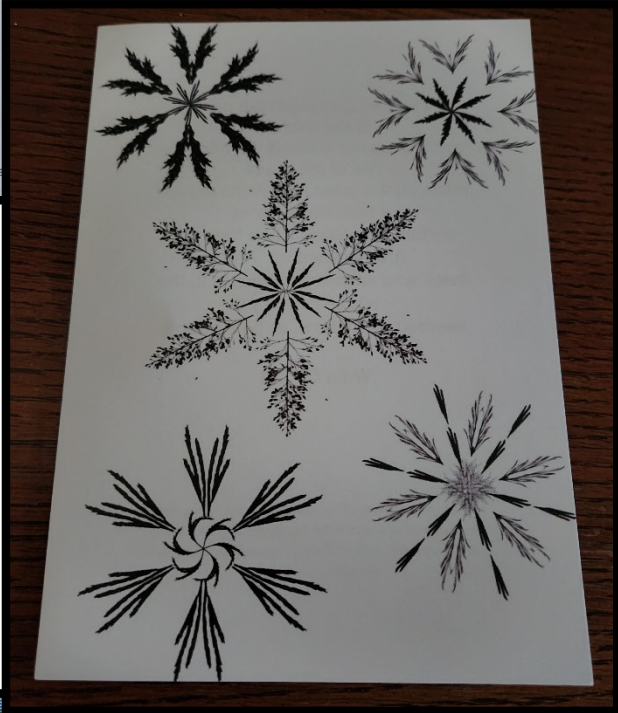
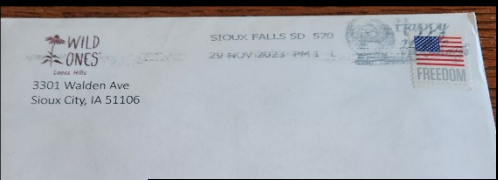


Weekly Wild Wednesday

With the Wild Iowa Crabapples, below, we decided to up-pot these and plant the whole POT in the ground, so we can let them develop more growth and root systems.

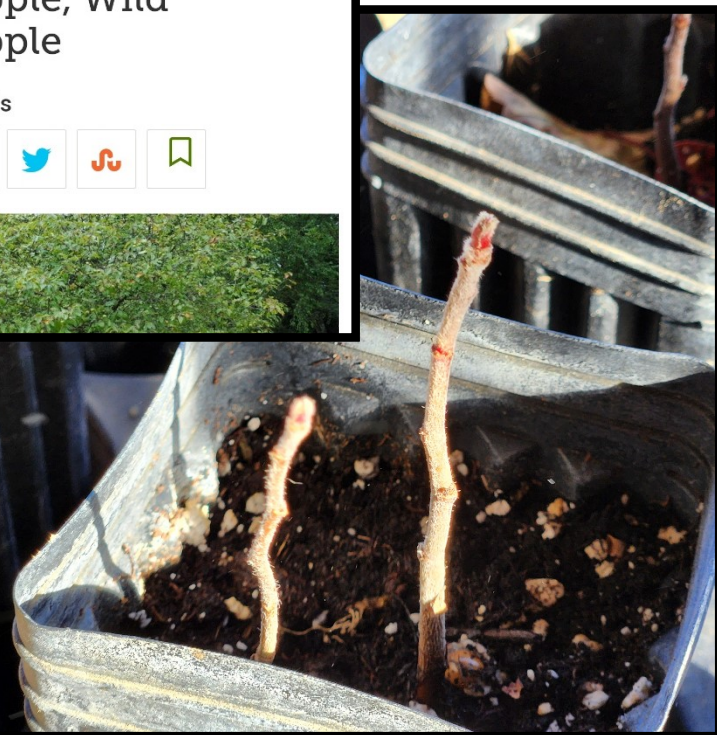
DORMANT PLANTS.
