

Pasque Flower

Anemone patens

- Soil: Dry Loess Hills Native
- Sun: Full
- Bloom time: early Spring (April, May)
- Height: 6 inches
- Color: White/Purple
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Rock gardens, dry prairie gardens mix with low growing flowers and grasses,
 Prairie Smoke, Blue-eyed Grass, June Grass



Wild Columbine Aquilegia Canadensis

- Soil: Avg to Dry Loess Hills Native
- Sun: Full to Part Shade
- Bloom time: Spring (June, July)
- Height: 1-2 feet
- Color: Red and Yellow
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Shade gardens or Full Sun Wild Geranium, Wild Phlox, beardtongue and golden alexander



Swamp/Rose/Marsh Milkweed Asclepias Incarnata

- Soil: Moist to Wet Loess Hills Native
- Sun: Full to Part Sun
- Bloom time: Summer (June, July, Aug)
- Height: 3-5 feet
- Color: Pink
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Main attraction or small groupings in rain gardens, along ponds or near the down spout! Grows well with blazing star, culvers root, joe pye weed, boneset or tall ironweed



Butterfly Weed Asclepias tuberosa

- Soil: Dry to Medium Loess Hills Native
- Sun: Full
- Bloom time: Summer (June, July, Aug)
- Height: 2-3 feet
- Color: Orange
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Main attraction or small groupings, dry gardens – mix with short prairie grasses, blazing star, virginia mountain mint, nodding onion, wild bergamot or spiderwort



White false Indigo Baptisia alba (B lactea, B leucantha)

- Soil: Medium to Moist Iowa native
- Sun: Full to Part
- Bloom time: Summer (June, July, Aug)
- Height: 3-5 feet
- Color: White
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Plant in groups of three to five in rain gardens, near bird baths or any garden setting. Plant short prairie grasses and flowers around the base to minimize weeds.



Curly style wood sedge Carex rosea

- Soil: Wet to Dry- Loess Hills Native
- Sun: Part Sun to Part Shade
- Bloom time: Spring (May, June)
- Height: 1 ft
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Looks great in small groups or mixed with a variety of low-growing woodland flowers




Wild Senna Cassia or senna hebecarpa

- Soil: Avg to Moist
- Sun: Full to Part
- Bloom time: Summer (July)
- Height: 3-5 feet
- Color: Yellow
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Can be a little on the aggressive side, plant with wild bergamot or flowering spurge. Great in bee gardens where it will attract a wide variety of pollinators, especially bees!



*Prairie/stiff Coreopsis Coreopsis palmata

- Soil: Medium to Dry
- Sun: Full to Part
- Bloom time: June, July, Aug
- Height: 2 feet
- Color: Yellow
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Use in bigger areas as it will spread by rhizomes to form a patch.
 - Attracts many pollinators and bee keepers consider it a good honey source.



Pale Purple Coneflower

- Soil: Dry to Medium Loess hills native
- Sun: Full
- Bloom time: Early Summer (May, June, July)
- Height: 3-5 feet
- Color: Purple
- Garden uses and companion plants
 - Butterfly gardens, informal borders, mix with wild quinine and prairie grasses



* Purple Lovegrass Eragrostis spectabilis

- Soil: Dry
- Sun: Full to Part (warm season grass)
- Bloom time: July, Aug
- Height: 2 feet
- Color: Green/Purple
- Garden uses and companion plants
 - Stunning addition to any rock garden or drier landscape



Rattlesnake Master Eryngium Yuccifolium

- Soil: Moist to Dry Iowa Native
- Sun: Full
- Bloom time: Late Summer (Aug, Sept)
- Height: 2-5 feet
- Color: white/green
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Main attraction or small groupings, in just about any garden setting – plant with blazing star for a great midsummer combo, shown here with false sunflower



Wild Geranium

Geranium maculatum

- Soil: Avg IA native
- Sun: Part to shade
- Bloom time: Late Spring (May, June)
- Height: 1-2 feet
- Color: Purple
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Shade Garden, woodland edges, can be a nice ground cover when planted in masses



Prairie Smoke Geum Triflorum

- Soil: Dry to Medium IA native
- Sun: Full
- Bloom time: Spring (May, June)
- Height: 1 ft
- Color: Pink/red
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Rock gardens, dry gardens. Plant in foreground between later blooming flowers and grasses, goes well with pussy toes, nodding wild onion and golden alexander



Prairie alumroot Heuchera richardsonii

- Soil: Avg to Dry IA native
- Sun: Part Sun, Part Shade
- Bloom time: Summer (June, July, Aug)
- Height: 2-3ft
- Color: Green
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Phlox, Pennsylvania sedge, heart-leaved golden alexander
 - Woodland gardens, plant in masses as a groundcover or decorative accent



*Northern Blue Flag Iris Iris versicolor

- Soil: Moist to Wet
- Sun: Full to part
- Bloom time: May June July
- Height: 3ft
- Color: Blue, Purple
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Canada anemone, cardinal flower, boneset
 - Attracts butterflies and humminbirds

Southern Blue Flag Iris Iris virginica

- Soil: Moist to Wet IA native
- Sun: Full
- Bloom time: Summer (June, July)
- Height: 2-3ft
- Color: Blue
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Canada anemone, cardinal flower, boneset



June Grass Koeleria cristata

- Soil: Dry Loess Hills Native
- Sun: Full
- Bloom time: Summer (May, June, July)
- Height: 2-3 feet
- Color: Green/Yellow
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Rock gardens, dry gardens. Mix with low growing dry prairie flowers like Prairie Smoke or Purple Prairie clover



*Dense or Marsh Blazing Star Liatris spicata

- Soil: Dry to moist, drought and moisture tolerant
- Sun: Full to part
- Bloom time: July, Aug, Sept
- Height: 2-5 ft
- Color: purple
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Butterfly weed, black-eyed susan, virginia mountain mint
 - Put in rain gardens, butterfly gardens, or any garden! Effective in masses! Mix with grasses and flowers for support



Wild Quinine Parthenium integrifolium

- Soil: Avg to Dry IA native
- Sun: Full
- Bloom time: Summer (June, July, Aug)
- Height: 2-3ft
- Color: White
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Rattlesnake master, purple coneflower, wild bergamot, nodding onion, butterfly weed, prairie blazing star
 - Rain gardens, informal gardens, prairie meadows



*Large flowered Beardtongue Penstemon grandiflorus

- Soil: Dry, sand or gravel
- Sun: Full
- Bloom time: May June
- Height: 2-4 ft
- Color: lavendar
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Best in dry gardens, sandy areas
 - Attracks hummingbirds and bumblebees



Prairie Phlox Phlox pilosa

- Soil: Dry to Moist Loess Hills Native
- Sun: Full to Part
- Bloom time: Spring (May, June, July)
- Height: 1-2 ft
- Color: Pink/purple
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Mass plantings (will require weeding) ground cover, border edges, informal gardens

Jacob's Ladder Polemonium reptans

- Soil: Avg to Moist
- Sun: Part sun to part shade
- Bloom time: Spring (April, May, June)
- Height: 1-2 ft
- Color: Blue/purple
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Violets, wild ginger, larger-flowered bellwort, rue anemone
 - Ground cover, woodland garden



Wild Petunia Ruellia humilis

- Soil: Dry to Medium
- Sun: Full to Part
- Bloom time: June, July, Aug, Sept
- Height: 1-2ft
- Color: Lavendar
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - **Prairie smoke**, shooting star
 - Hummingbird garden, informal garden, prairie garden in the foreground



*Little Blue Stem Schizachyrium scoparium

- Soil: Dry to Medium (warm season grass)
- Sun: Full to Part
- Bloom time: July Oct
- Height: 3ft
- Color: green/blue; copper in fall/winter
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Companion grasses include big bluestem, Indian grass, switch grass
 - Sky blue aster, **rattlesnake master**, nodding onion, **golden alexander**



Royal Catchfly Silene regia

- Soil: medium
- Sun: Full
- Bloom time: July October
- Height: 2-4 ft
- Color: Red
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Short grasses and flowers to help control weeds
 - Small groups, hummingbird gardens, informal gardens, prairie meadows



Prairie Dropseed Sporobolus heterolepis

- Soil: Dry to Moist Loess Hills Native
- Sun: Full
- Bloom time: Late Summer (Aug, Sept)
- Height: 2-4 ft
- Color: gold
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - Wild flowers
 - Front borders, transition from garden to lawn, informal gardens, prairie meadows

Heart leafed Golden Alexander Zizia aptera

- Soil: Medium to Moist
- Sun: Full to Part
- Bloom time: May, June, July
- Height: 1-2 ft
- Color: yellow
- Garden uses and companion plants:
 - **Prairie smoke**, pussy toes, hyacinth, little blue stem, side oats gramma
 - Foreground areas, informal gardens, prairie meadows
