
## Weekly Wild Wednesday June 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024 What a Week of "Working the Wild!"

Dawn and Nelle and I worked on the Brome --and marking good Native Plants in the Pocket Prairie today!! ← Dawn, Nelle and I worked on removing Brome, small tree seedlings, and hardly any Leafy Spurge from the <u>Friends of Stone Park</u> Pocket Prairie! The method we have used on the Leafy Spurge is to pull it and trash it when it is in full bloom. The first year there were 37 bags of bloomin' spurge, now in year 4 there were just a few blooms! It is definitely worth it on a small area to pull and trash those future seed heads and stress the plant when all the energy is above ground-- according to our <u>Citizen Science project</u>!

## Honeyvine, a species Swallow-wort


Also known as:

- Smooth swallow-wort

Botanical name: Cynanchum laeve
