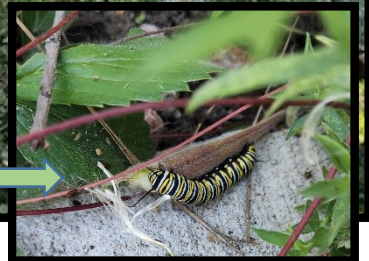
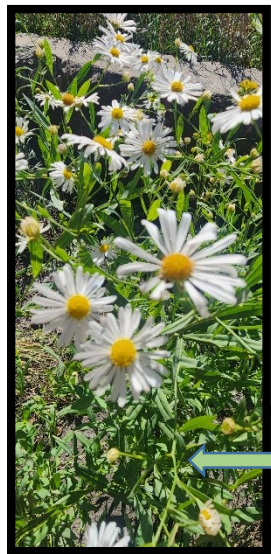


# Weekly Wild Wednesday

September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2024

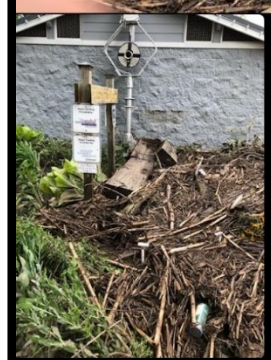
What a Week of "Railroads & Remembrance!"

The green line on the building designates the high water mark!

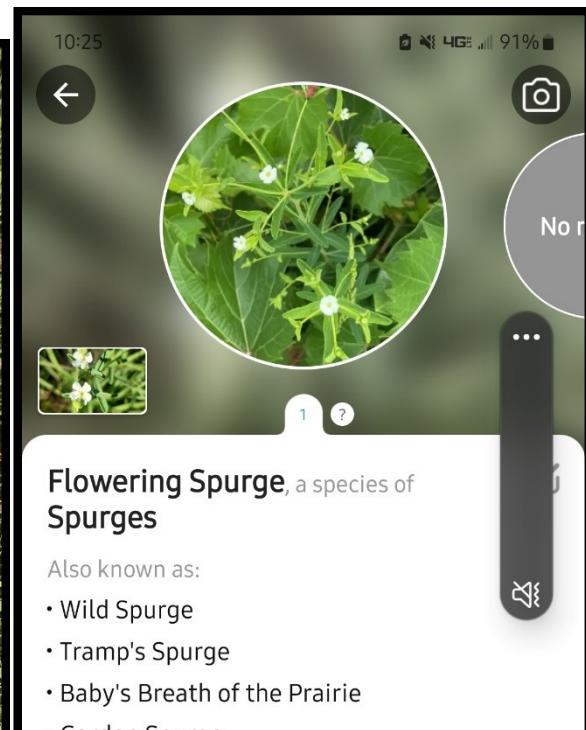
Native plants ARE resilient!
