From Sioux City proper, go THROUGH Stone State Park to HWY 12. Go North along the river, looking for wildlife, all the way to Butcher Road. Drive (on gravel) to Broken Kettle Grasslands overlook. There's a bench to sit on if the weather is nice! Look for buffalo ALL ALONG this route! Then keep going until you hit North Ridge Road. Turn right, and after Dotty and Bill's driveway with the huge John Deere Mailbox, keep looking for prairie flowers and their named prairie signs. It's a lovely drive! Keep going until you hit K18, go right on K18, left on Hwy 12 and back through Stone State Park for a WONDERFUL scenic Loop Route!
