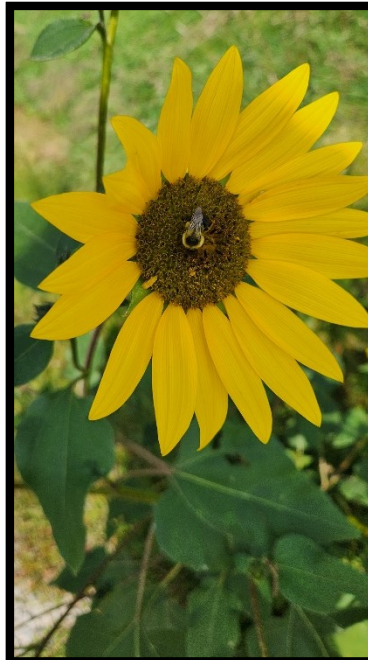


**We learned so much
