We saw a lot of lingering wildflowers among the seed heads at Oak Ridge Conservation Area! It is Bow Season, so wear **BRIGHT** colors if you head down there! This Giant Yellow Hyssop looked like a Nature Candelabra! And the Silky Aster seed head fooled us into thinking it was Cut leaf Iron Plant with its **SUPER** fluffy head, bigger than we had ever seen!



Then we popped over to Jana's to put in a few shallow rooted plants that re-seed readily for her **VERY COOL** (But **NOT** freezing) Century Farm Root Cellar roof!

Most goldenrods have deep growing roots, but GrowItBuildIT 'showcases' (ha!) that 'Showy' Goldenrod has shallow, fibrous rhizomes!

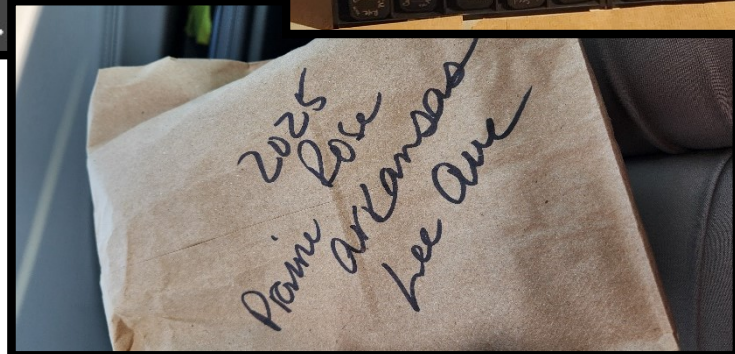
Prairie Hills hosted a burn at their property, with students from Dr. Hazlett's class!
